If you are a teenager, you are already on your way to Adulthood.

Sometimes it can be a real pain trying to figure that out all by yourself. In this group we will put our heads and our hearts together to sort out some of the issues that young men face.

Five Major questions will be considered:

1. How do we define manhood?
2. How do we treat ourselves?

Many issues underlying these questions will be discussed: freedom, responsibility, honor, integrity, sexuality, aggression, grieving, playfulness, relationships, cultural/societal/legal issues, school/family/sports pressures, etc.

The goal is for teenagers to gain a better understanding of themselves, their relationships with others and their place in the community.
